



Man and woman face three charges, Over 1,200 DVDs seized

On Thursday, October 15, 2009, officers attended the Home Market Variety store, 575 Rogers Road.

It is alleged that:

- police attended the store to conduct a tobacco inspection, under the Smoke Free Ontario Act,
- over 1,000 pirated DVDs were on display for sale,
- the videos were seized and sent to the Canadian Motion Picture Distributors Association for analysis.

It is further alleged:

- on Friday, January 15, 2010, police returned to the store and found another 200 pirated DVDs on display for sale,
- the videos were seized and sent to the Canadian Motion Picture Distributors Association for analysis.

Bo Lin, 32, of Toronto, has been charged with two counts of Expose or Offer for Sale Infringing Copies.

Min Lin (female), 29, of Richmond Hill, has been charged with one count of Expose or Offer for Sale Infringing Copies.

Both accused are schedule to appear in court at Old City Hall on Friday, February 26, 2010, room 114, 9 a.m.
